**WARNING NOTICE AND CEASE AND DESIST  
(Entertainers whose Breasts or Buttocks are Exposed  
Must be Twenty-one Years of Age or Older)**

To All Licensees with Adult Entertainers:

On November 16, 2018, the Federal Fifth Circuit Court of Appeal issued an opinion in *Doe I v. Landry*, No. 17-30292, 2018 WL 6009239, wherein it vacated the injunction prohibiting enforcement of Act 395 from the 2016 regular session of the Louisiana Legislature after holding that the Act was neither unconstitutionally overbroad nor vague.

As a result, Act 395's requirement that entertainers whose breasts or buttocks are exposed must be twenty-one years of age or older and corresponding local ordinances requiring same are being enforced. **As such, you are immediately ordered to comply with Louisiana law by requiring that all entertainers whose breasts or buttocks are exposed to view be twenty-one years of age or older and to cease and desist in allowing entertainers under twenty-one years of age to expose their breasts or buttocks.**
